Meeting called to order 6:36 pm.

Council Business:

Approval of the January minutes: Approval deferred.

Big focus of February meeting was advocacy priorities. On the CBE website there is information on school trustee priorities and information on advocacy, including impacts to CBE due to increased student enrollment and an increase in English Language Learners. There are different one-pagers that may be of interest – CBE is prioritizing need for learning spaces across CBE, increase to base funding and increase to funding to support English Language Learners. There also links to contact MLAs.

CBE was not consulted or engaged on government's recent announcement regarding gender policies. CBE will be engaging with government to try to understand this announcement.

Social Studies curriculum was discussed – in 2024/2025, opportunity to pilot the updated K-6 Social Studies curriculum and provide feedback.

Education Plan is being set for the next 3-year period. There are some new schools planned for Calgary.

Treasurer Report:

- West Coast Seeds raised \$695.57 (cheque arrives in May), easy to organize in case this is of interest for future years.
- Wildwood School Council balance is \$16,126.06, with a cheque pending to our DJ for Kokomo for \$450 with most of that going to the performers. A huge thank you to David for his role in Kokomo!
- Wildwood merchandise was sold as a fundraiser. Spend was \$3,356.51, this has already been recouped. It will be also advertised on the community Facebook page.
- Healthy Hunger cheque to be deposited \$2,136.04 (for December & January).
- March expenditures \$757 for float has been reimbursed. \$4,778.10 deposit from Kokomo (includes \$80 merchandise sold), paid \$374 in concession and \$83.84 in prizes. Pizza bill was

\$1,020. DJ & entertainment was \$450. Sold \$4,009 in pre-ticket sales. Credit card fees to be subtracted from this.

- o Total expenses \$1,928.45,
- Wildwood Merchandise spend \$3,356, sold \$2,292.35 so far. Final number TBD.

Wildwood has added a total of 4.2-4.5 FTE between September and March.

Support staff has been increased as well.

Funding Requests

- Request for 600 new mini white boards these are used daily, all day long. Would also require erasers and pens. \$1,150.
- Request for support to do work in the Wildwoods. \$5,000.
- Request for support to purchase 30 new Chromebooks & carts right now we do not have enough for the students we have. \$15,000.

Top three requests eligible for the casino account. ~\$18k remaining in previous casino total.

Total funding request \$21,150 to the Friends of Wildwood School Society casino account.

Request for funding for coding residency \$9,000. Can request for permission to fund this from the AGLC but for now will put through the Wildwood School Council.

Diane motioned to approve \$9,000 for funding for the coding residency from the Wildwood School Council Account. Stacey seconded. Motion carried.
